<p>(1) Under §745.8925 of this subchapter (relating to How do I qualify for a provisional Child-Care Administrator's License (CCAL) if I do not meet the management or supervisory experience required for a full CCAL?)</p>	<p>(A) For two years from the date we issue the permit; and (B) Is not eligible for renewal.</p>
<p>(2) Under §745.8913(b) of this subchapter (relating to Can my licensure in another state qualify me for an administrator's license?)</p>	<p>(A) 180 days after the permit is issued; and (B) May be extended one time for an additional 180 days.</p>
